Current Meeting Business

CCN List Updates

- ATC Members vote to approve title changes:
 - ANTH& 210 Indigenous Peoples of North America – **vote on in ATC** (Current title: Indians of N America)
 - ANTH& 216 Indigenous Peoples of the Northwest Coast – **vote on in ATC** (Current title: NW Coast Indians)
- If these course title revisions are approved, they go to Instruction Commission (IC) this fall for final approval, along with the following changes approved in spring 2023:
 - POLS& 202 United States Government (title change)
 - CMST& 240 Intercultural Communication (addition of this course to the list)

New and Continuing Proposals (to be voted on spring 2024)

- Addition of EDUC& 240 Diversity in Education – brand new (Sally fwded form), ECED 240 at LWTech. No issues will be consistent w/ other EDUC& courses. Remind that ECE does not have common outcomes for common courses. Prefix, number, title, and credits are the only common items for common core courses.
 - Taught primarily in Early Childhood Education program
 - Most colleges are already teaching to a common course outline.
 - Proposed by North Seattle College
 - All ATC members at colleges that offer the course should seek feedback from faculty who teach it and be ready to share at the winter 2024 meeting. **An addition of EDUC& 240 has been proposed, please talk to faculty that teach current version of course and get feedback for Winter 24 meeting.**
- Revision of PSYC& 220 Abnormal Psychology title – Psychopathology has most support b/c of APA, don't need to follow UW guidelines, WSU no equivalent course at 200 level.
 - Initially discussed last academic year; no consensus reached; new revisions suggested
 - Proposed by Lake Washington Institute of Technology
 - Possible title changes after others were eliminated last year:
 - Psychopathology (term to which the APA and the formerly titled journal of *Abnormal Psychology* have shifted)
 - Psychological Disorders
 - Behavior Disorders (UW Seattle's title; Note: UW's equivalency tables with our colleges list PSYCH 2XX as the transfer course awarded for PSYC& 220 – a 200-level PSYCH elective, not their course by this title)
 - All ATC members at colleges that offer the course should seek feedback from faculty who teach it and be ready to share at the winter 2024 meeting. **Get feedback and share in Winter.**
- ANTH& 218 Indians of Pacific NW – **Proposed: Indigenous Peoples of the Pacific NW** proposing to ATC along w/ other ANTH& courses. Not currently being taught at any college.

Between/Future Meeting Business

Updates to CCN Titles

- With all colleges on ctcLink, the character limit on titles is now longer (30 characters). A review of all common courses is proposed to eliminate odd abbreviations that were made for the prior system wherever possible.
 - **Please ask your curriculum colleagues if they would like to be involved with this project. (if yes, email Sally)**

Revisions of CCN Proposal Form

- **Is the new CCN form accessible? Double check w/ Sally – if not accessible can it be made accessible?**
 - Clarify process on the form itself
 - Add additional guidance about how to complete each section
- Work remaining from last year
 - Include equity-related considerations
 - **Discuss “&” in CCN numbering – want to remove so all courses use exact same prefix**
 - Not many CCN courses when CCN prefix began
 - Collect descriptions and outline for PSYC& 100 and ENGL& 101 – **report back for Winter 23 meeting**
 - Why are institutions offering CCN courses at varying credits? What is the history?
 - Revisit active/inactive CCN list (Sally has access to list?)
