## Introduction

The Image/Upgrade Overview Document is intended to provide ctcLink users with a summary of the changes that will be made in the system as a result of the upcoming image or PeopleTools upgrade implementation. Oracle releases multiple PeopleSoft updates, called images, for each pillar every year. Each Image contains bug fixes and features that are important for PeopleSoft to work well. PeopleTools upgrades update the underlying framework of the system. There are minimal changes that are noticeable to the end users. Below is an overview of the changes that you can expect to see as part of this upgrade.

### **Employee Self Service**

#### **Paychecks**

Prior to the 24-D tax update -

- To filter the paychecks, users had to access multiple pop-ups. This was not user friendly.
- The Paychecks page had a Filter push button which when accessed in screen reader mode would be set to "pressed" state and when the user tabbed to the filter button, assistive technology would announce it as "Filter toggle button pressed. To toggle the state press bar." This was confusing to screen reader users.

After the 24-D tax update –

- Page level instructions are directly added on Paychecks page to orient the screen reader users on why there are pre-applied filters and how to change them.
- The filter push button paradigm has been replaced with the "from date", "to date" and an "apply" button directly on the page.
