Wa Arts Commission: 12/15/23: - Artwork was successfully installed in September of 2023. Note: The artist could be held responsible for potential project delays/costs due to the GC receiving artwork much later than anticipdated as well as the artist not being available for timely supervision of the installation. Additionally, GC provided support for unloading pieces from shipping containers that was unforeseen and not accommodated by the artist or ArtsWa.

- SFCC/CCS Administration has named the new facility ska-hét (anglicized) or såxetk* (Salish) - meaning "rapids" or "fast water." This was the word that the tribes used to talk about Spokane Falls as well as a generalized name for the entire Spokane River. SFCC collaborated with the Spokane Tribe.

NOTE: Payment to Fraudulent account occurred on 7/31/23 in the amount of \$1,001,457.65. A second payment for the same amount was paid to the contractor for construction services associated with Project 2018-063 | (3-3) Invoice 21R. The additional expenditure is not accounted for in the above totals. Work continues with the Attorney General and Federal agencies to recover these fraudulant expenses. A portion of these funds have been recovered as of November 2024.
